



DECEMBER 2, 2019

ABSENT: Danny Grant, Cyndi Smiley, Sheree Flippin, Denise Gaddy, Krissy Thompson Dirk opened with prayer and called the meeting to order.

Any Ministry Team reports from last month are to be given to Teresa.

A very special thank you was expressed to Jim Cash, Mitch Moore and Nancy Thomas, who have faithfully served on the Church Board and will be leaving this year.

We also welcomed our new members: Frankie Hollingsworth, Cyndi Smiley, Dawn Hollingsworth, Tracey Chappell, Denise Gaddy, Shelby Cash, and Jimmy Madison.

Motion was made to accept the minutes from the 11.10.19 Congregational Business Meeting. Seconded. DISCUSSION: There was an error in wording, and should be stated as follows (corrections are highlighted)

*Building Fund/Savings Account Report January 2019 – September 2019:

Motion made to move \$40,000.00 from the General Fund Checking Account (currently \$117,604.68) to the BUILDING FUND PRINCIPAL to pay towards the BUILDING MORTGAGE PRINCIPAL. Seconded. Discussion - Jim Cash noted that last year (2018) at this time, the BUILDING MORTGAGE BALANCE was \$859,000. The balance today is \$759,136 and should be close to \$700,000 by December 31st.

Building Fund/Savings Account Report January 2019 – September 2019 {with the \$40,000.00 moved from the General Fund Checking Account} was unanimously approved. Motion carried.

Motion made to amend the wording in the paragraph above. Seconded. Motion carried.

Motion was made to approve Frankie Hollingsworth as Church Board Vice Chairman.

Seconded. Unanimously approved. Motion carried. No new business.

Nancy Thomas reported that \$900.00 was received from a wedding/reception this past Saturday. They did a very nice job in cleaning up! These monies will go toward the Building Mortgage Principal. Sharon Moore, new Church Board Chairman, presided over the continuation of the meeting. Dirk will help with the transition. Dirk will be heading up the Gifts and Discernment Team, and they will be working alongside with Ministry Teams and the Congregation.

January Church Board Retreat: The Executive Team will get together to plan the Retreat, including meal and when and where. January 12th, after Worship, may be the best day with January 19th as the inclement weather date. Goals will be discussed during the Retreat and Ministry Teams should have a planning meeting before then. Sharon will send out an email to confirm.

Goals should be given to Teresa by January 20th, 2020, so she can prepare them to give to Edna. Edna will then need to print packets to have them available 2 weeks prior to the SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 9TH Congregational Business Meeting (Date in the Church Board Handbook is incorrect, February 16th will be the inclement weather date).

Sharon is excited about this upcoming year. We have an awesome group to do the Lord's will. Thank you for serving, and welcome to all new members!

MISSIONARY Update

Hello Brothers and Sisters of White Hill: Currently, our hearts are pleasantly overwhelmed! We write to you the morning after Sunday, Dec. 29, when our sending church, Central Baptist in Columbus, Ohio had a special send-off service for us before we leave for Zimbabwe very early next Sunday morning, Jan 5. Many brothers and sisters participated in making it a truly wonderful day. Several Pastors from Ohio, Indiana, and Virginia joined in the evening, offering a word to us, pointing our eyes to our faithful God! We have a Father "who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think according to the power at work within us" (Eph. 3:20).

We're remembering that "No soldier gets entangled in civilian pursuits, since his aim is to please the one who enlisted him" (2 Tim. 2:4). This calling to Zimbabwe—or to anything for that matter, brother or sister—is all about the **Sender**. It is not about what we might deem "the mission" or what we might focus on accomplishing, but it's about our Enlister! He is a wonderful Savior! He is the One who we must seek to please! As we keep our eyes on Him, and our hearts focused on His will, we will remain in the will and calling of our Sender.

In Revelation 4 & 5, John was privileged to see a "people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation" who had been ransomed by the blood of Christ (5:9). John saw them, and now we get to share in gathering them in! John saw Zimbabweans, Shona men and women, from the unreached VaDoma tribe, and we have the joy of participating in getting them there! Hallelujah! And you do too, White Hill! You are little "s" senders, following the will of the Sender, getting us sent! And we rejoice that we're not just being sent, but we are being sustained! And that not merely financially, but through the prayers of the saints being offered to the Sender.

We are spending this last week in the States getting things packed and weighing suitcases, signing our will, saying goodbyes, planning for a big trip with three young kids (about 24hrs in the flights and layovers)! There are lots of little, seemingly "unspiritual" parts of obeying Christ, but He is a worthy of everything, every detail! In Luke 17:10, Christ said, "So you also, when you have done all that you were commanded say, "We are unworthy servants; we have only done
