MINISTRY TEAMS' VISION

Vision for the Worship Ministry Team is as follows:

The Worship Ministry Team seeks to support the pastor in all things related to the worship services held at White Hill. Our deep desire is to see the body of believers at White Hill Church worship the Lord in spirit and in truth, and in the freedom and deliverance that true worship brings.

We are actively seeking additional participant "ministers" for service support functions such as sound, computer, etc., to enhance our worship experience(s). We are developing plans for several Sunday evening services throughout the year, as well as a revival in the fall.

Vision for the **Spiritual Formation Ministry Team**

To spend more time in prayer as a team and as a church – seeking His face, His will, His direction. Help ensure Sunday School teachers have the tools and resources they need, and determine whether they're still passionately serving in their current roles or are being led to serve in other ways. Meet with teaching team for Youth, Kingdom Kids and Pre-K to discuss vision, direction and curriculum. Explore offering some form of Spiritual Gifts class, with an emphasis on living in the Holy Spirit to more effectively follow His leading. Encourage the church body to strengthen our discipleship and faith-sharing.

Vision for Fellowship Ministry Team

To facilitate times, places, and events where our congregation can come together in the presence of God and accomplish His will through fellowship.

Vision for <u>Missions Ministry Team</u> is looking to be more involved in not just our missionaries overseas, but a lot of mission work right here in our community.

- 1. Community Aid Bins in the Church for food pantries
- 2. Missionaries in the Church, "Service Saturdays" helping elderly people in the church with whatever they may need.
- 3. "Service Saturdays" for people in the community Salvation Army, Valley Mission, Habitat, etc.
- 4. Disaster Relief, whether asking for special tithes for certain families in the community who have lost homes due to fires/floods, etc. As well as helping out in our region by going on mission trips to help out communities that are going through building back from hurricanes, storms, etc.

Vision for <u>Community Evangelism Ministry Team</u> is to *listen* for the Word of the Lord and to carry the Good News of the gospel to the World. Pointing people to Jesus by giving a cold cup of water to a thirsty person rather than praying someone else will.

Vision for **Stewards Ministry Team**

We continue to seek the Lord in all things and are so excited for the new year and our vision as a growing ministry team. It is our desire to seek out ways to use the resources the Lord has blessed us with to provide discipling and leadership to our youth. The playground continues to be an ongoing project that we are praying about for completion this year. Some other visions we have are a walking path around the property along the boundaries and through the woods. Also, soon we will be getting estimates on line stripping the parking lot. Other visions include getting more folks involved, including the youth, with some things such as a garden and pumpkin patch on the property. We will continue to support other ministry teams.
